The new Legislative landscape and policy priorities

- New administration is different, new members. New speaker changed rules and is a different process.
- New speaker of house wants to cut budget by 1 to 1.5 billion to accommodate for new health and education expenses anticipated in a few years.
- Rule change: cannot ask for recurring funds.
- Legislature wants to find existing money to fund programs. Has requested justification for 7 to 12 of our programs. May raid from one to support another.
- Getting any new money will be difficult with new rules and goals
- New guidelines in house rules lobbyist needs to get online to register to talk with each senator or congressman about a specific topic.
- Are free to talk about non-legislative stuff; faculty can answer these questions as long as they aren't lobbying. If you invite them to see project, that is lobbying and must be registered.
- If contacted and you're unsure about how to answer question to avoid lobbying, call Mary Ann for advice.
- Memo will come out tomorrow to explain new ethics rules for lobbying
