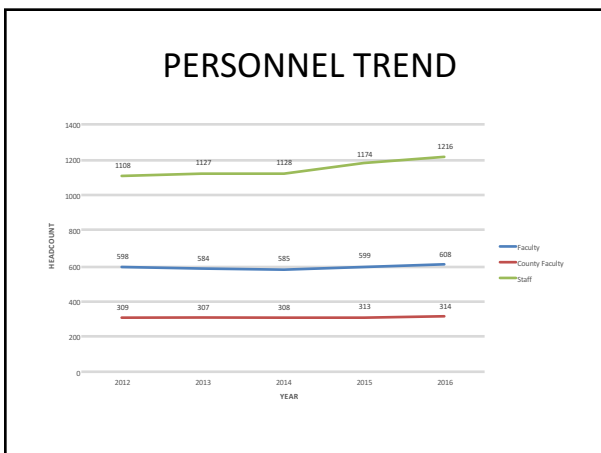



IFAS SALARY PERSONNEL SNAPSHOT

- ### TEACHING RCM FORMULA
- RCM formula driven by student tuition*:
 - 70% of tuition collected from students we teach;
 - 30% of tuition collected from our majors
 - PLUS a fixed "General Fund Supplement"
 - Less 10% "tax" on tuition to pay for UF Support Units
- *Undergraduate Out-of-State tuition goes to Provost

- ### Sponsored Projects Administration
- Revenue Based: charged against all Indirect Cost collected July-June
 - Distributions will remain the same*:
 - PI gets 10%
 - Department gets 15%
 - Dean gets 25%
 - SVP gets 50%
