

My name is Lisa Lundy. I am an Associate Professor, teaching agricultural communication, in the Department of Agricultural Education and Communication (AEC). I also serve as the undergraduate coordinator for the department, as well as an affiliate faculty member of the UF/IFAS Center for Public Issues Education (PIE Center). Prior to arriving at UF, from 2004 to 2015. I was a faculty member at Louisiana State University in the Manship School of Mass Communication. I was an SEC Academic Leadership Fellow in 2011-2012, participating in a year-long professional development program that seeks to identify, prepare and advance academic leaders for roles within SEC institutions and beyond. My appointment is 60% teaching, 10% research and 30% extension. I teach courses and conduct Extension trainings in science communication, public opinion and social media. My research examines how citizens use various forms of media to learn about and develop attitudes toward science. For the last few years, I've served on the Faculty Assembly's Professional Welfare Committee (as member and chair). I believe strongly in faculty governance. I look forward to Faculty Assembly playing an important role as UF/IFAS enters a time of leadership transition and responding to the challenges of COVID-19.
